### QUESTION OF THE WEEK—Applying the Gospel

The Disaster Response Team is pleased to announce that we have been selected to host one of the five meetings during WPDE News Channel 15's Hurricane Week set for August 2-6. We will be hosting the meeting scheduled for Friday, August 6. The doors of the Founders Center will open at 6:30PM and the Town Meeting will begin promptly at 7:30PM and end by 9:00PM. Ed Piotrowski from News Channel 15 and Randy Webster, director of Horry County Emergency Management, will speak for 15-20 minutes. A panel of other local experts will be present and answer any questions from the floor. We will have a Spanish Interpreter available for the meeting. The 6:00PM and 7:00PM weather portion of the Channel 15 news for that evening will be broadcast live from the Founders Center. 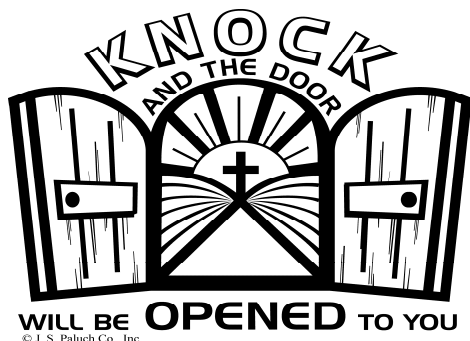
